

About the Project

The Cycling Museum of Minnesota (CMM) in partnership with the Hennepin History Museum (HHM) presents LifeCYCLE: Stories from the Minnesota Bike Community, a photography exhibition opening December 1. A multifaceted diary of bike enthusiasts currently living and riding in the state, the exhibition will feature original portraits of selected cyclists commissioned from celebrated Minneapolis photographer, Nancy Musinguzi. Visitors will encounter first-person insights into the lives of each one of these individuals in their own words, as collected through interviews. The exhibit will be accompanied by a series of dialogues between individuals profiled in the show.

ABOUT NANCY MUSINGUZI

Nancy Musinguzi is a visual storyteller, mixed-media artist and freelance photojournalist working and living in Minneapolis, Minnesota. They experiment with both traditional and emerging processes in media-making to document the lives and perspectives of marginal cultures, communities, and voices that chronicle and shape the contemporary American experience. The eleven subjects were selected by a jury built from CMM's Collections and Exhibits Committee. "Notable" or "influential" in this context includes persons who have done important work for the cycling community, are a known force in the cycling community, and/or experienced a valuable life change as a direct result of cycling. The subjects were chosen to represent the diverse backgrounds, ages, gender identities, and ethnicities found in the cycling community. Subjects include bike racers and athletes, established artists and makers, cycling and transportation activists, industry leaders, and shop owners and mechanics.
